PRESENTATION

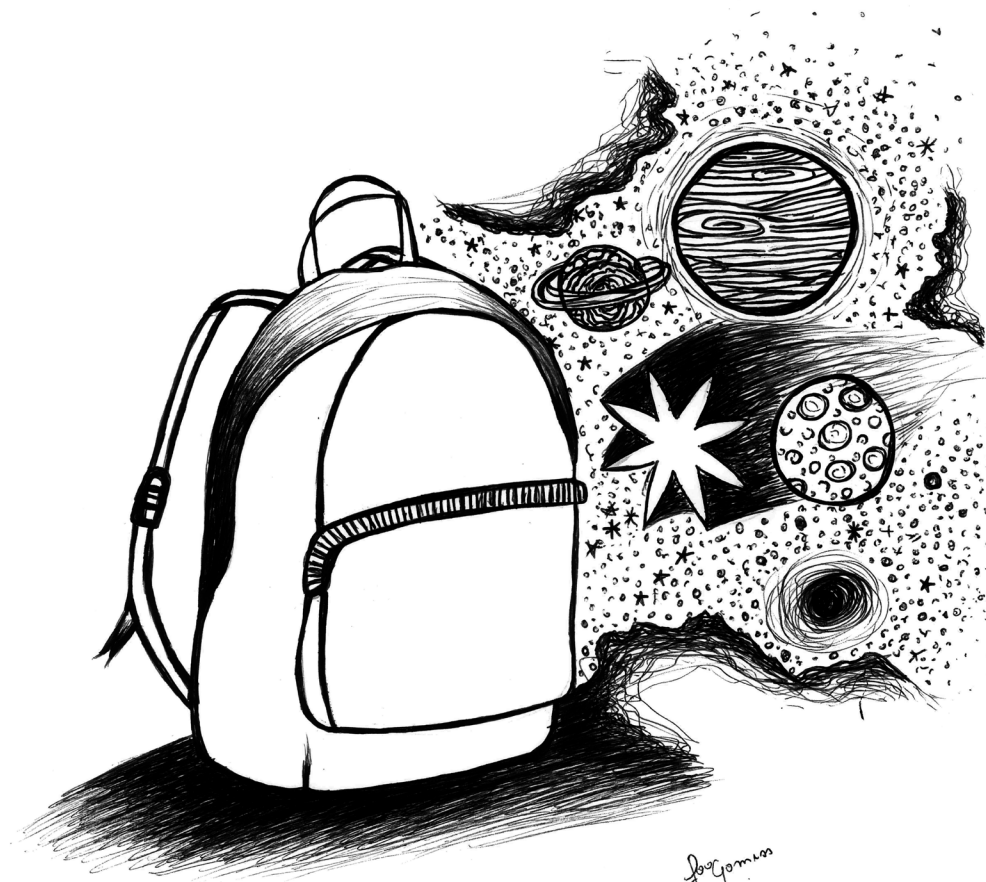

My life in Sepam

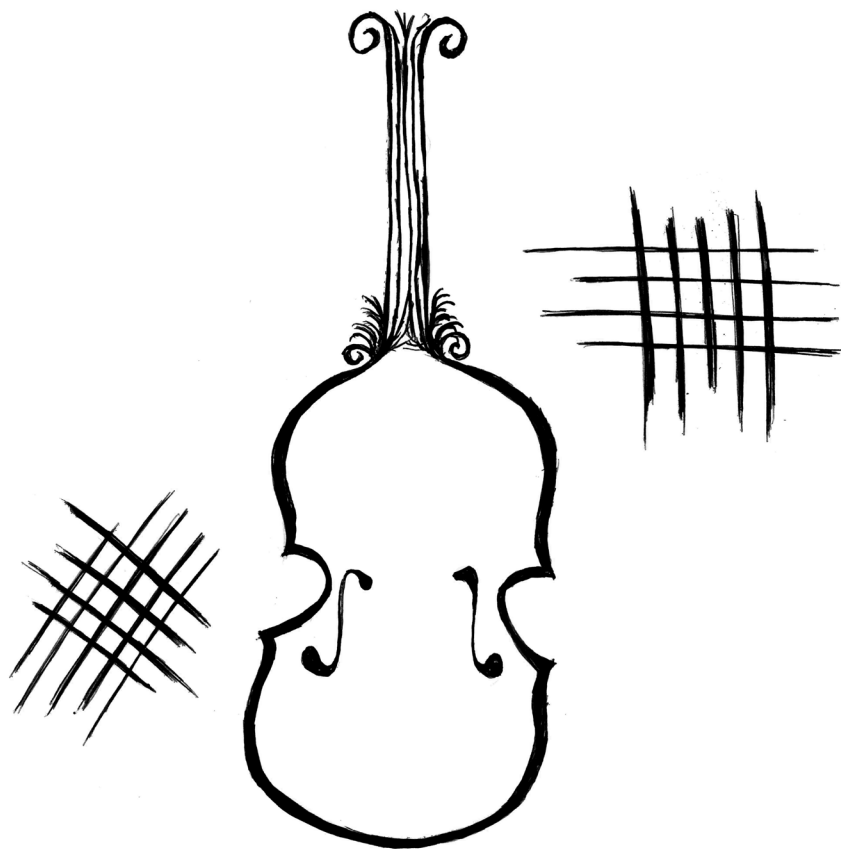

The great study

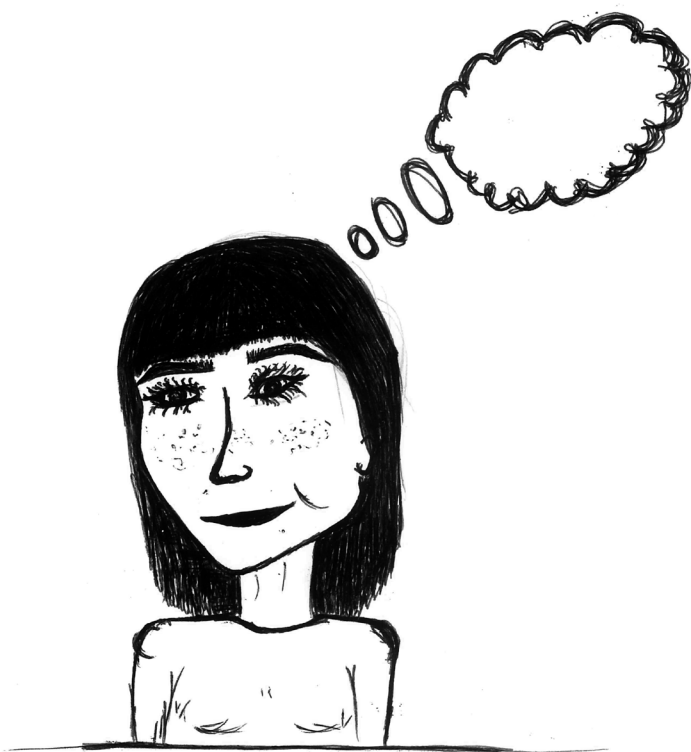

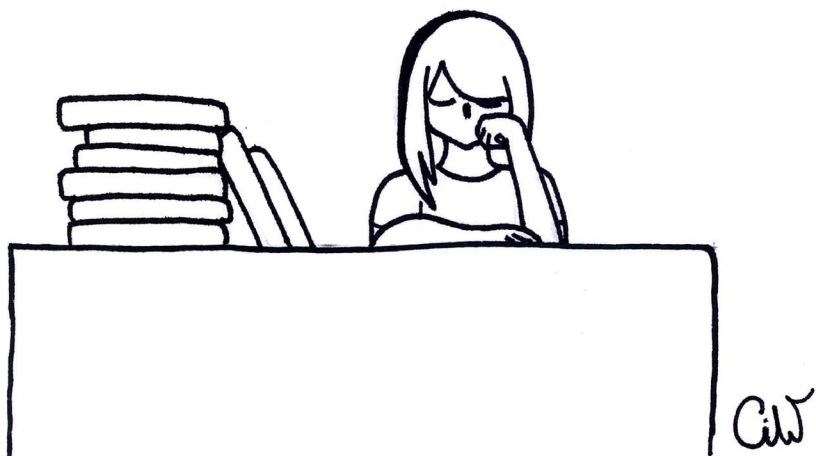
The things we can do at Sepam

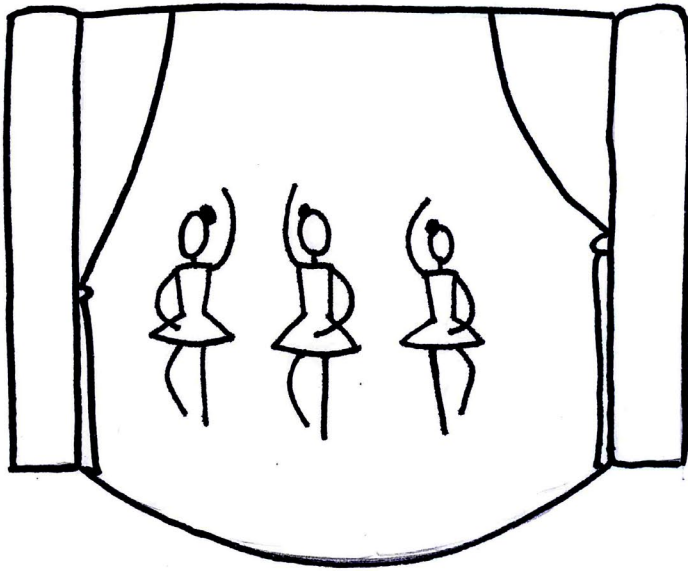
My Academic Life

My trajectory at school

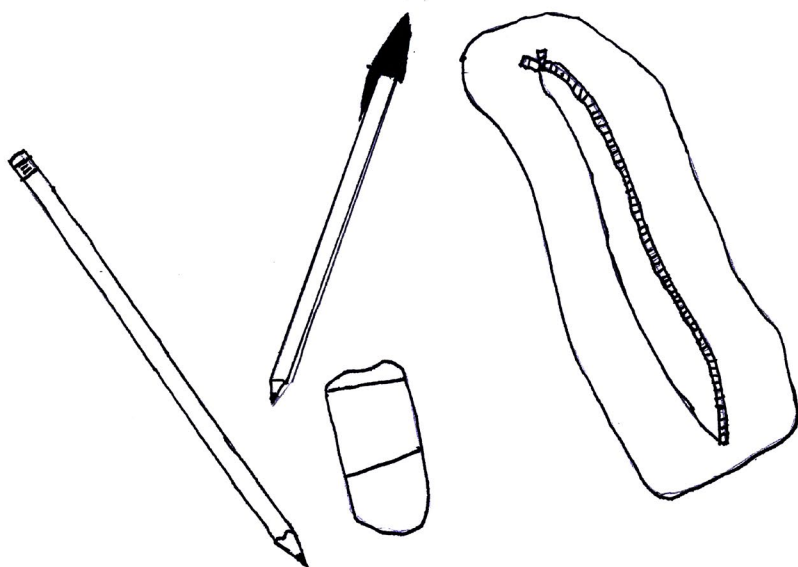

My name is Gustavo, I'm 14 years old and I started to study here at Sepam when I was only 3. I really don't remember my first school day, but I remember that Caio was already here.

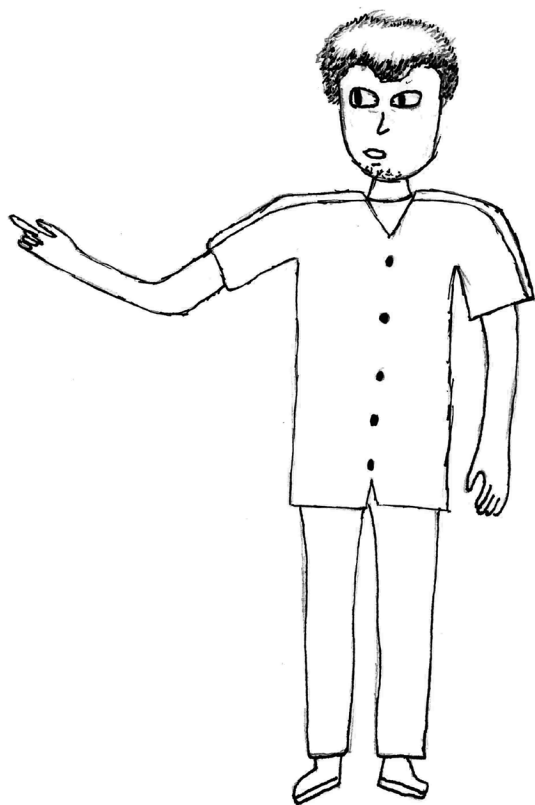

My name is Jonas Schossig Pereira, I wasn't born here in Ponta Grossa, but I moved in when I was 10 years old, in the 4th grade.

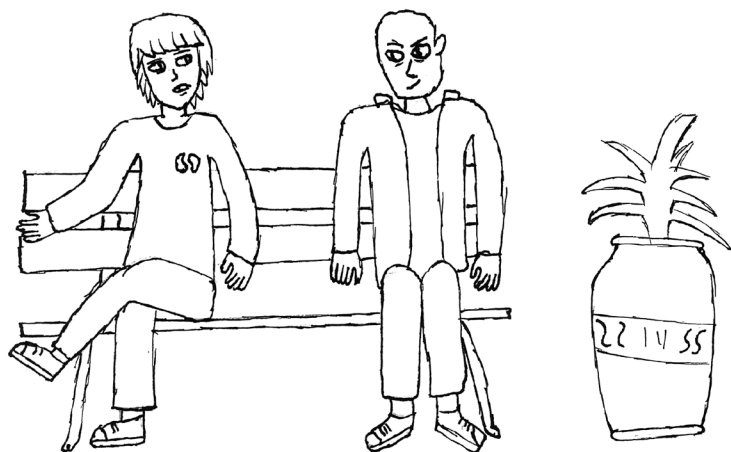

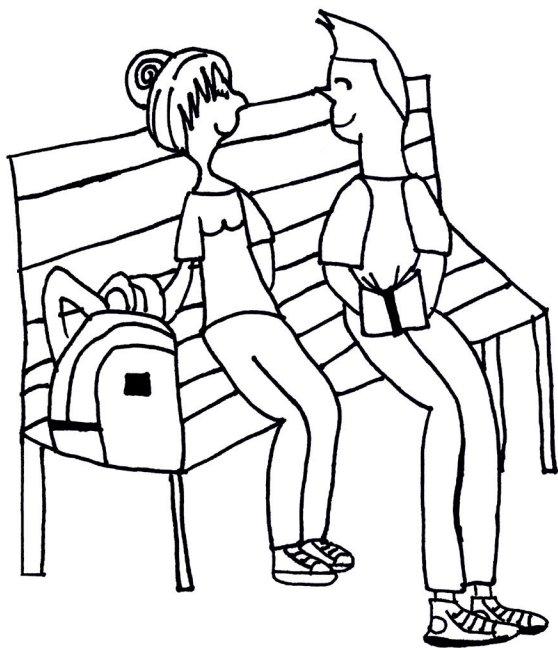

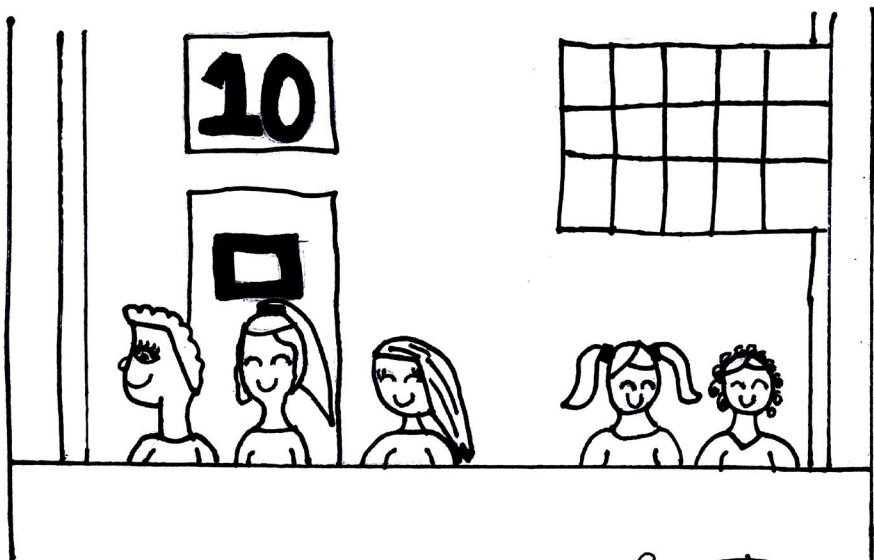
A bit of my life in Sepam

Memories

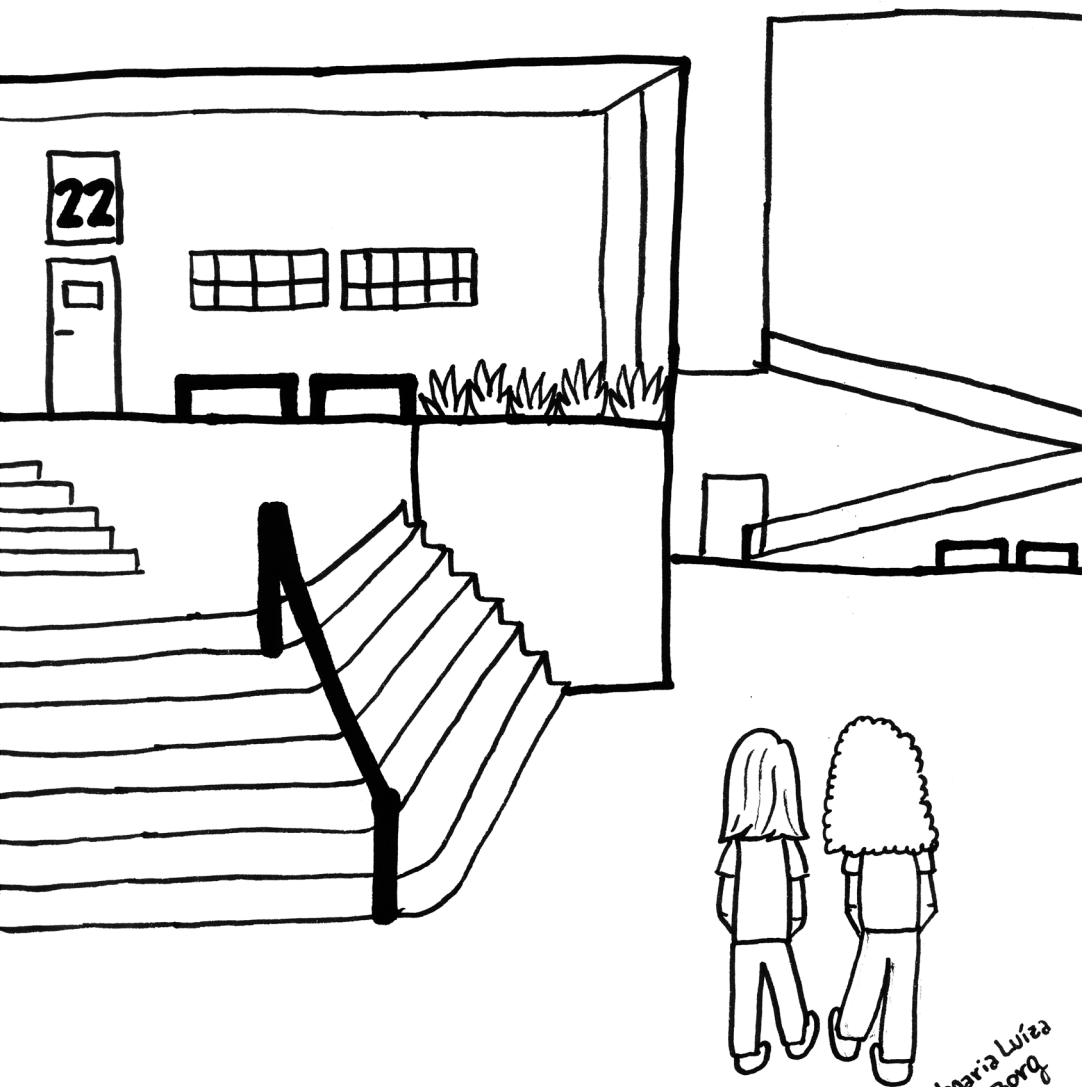
